The Aide's Role in Understanding Mental Health Disorders *Presented By: Jan Helsper, RN*

According to the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH), an estimated 13 million American adults (approximately 1 in 17) have a seriously debilitating mental illness. Mental illnesses, such as depression and anxiety, affect people's ability to participate in health-promoting behaviors. In turn, problems with physical health, such as chronic diseases, can have a serious impact on mental health and decrease a person's ability to participate in their plan of care. The in-home aide will be able to describe some of the more common types of mental illnesses and how they can impact the patient's life. Tips on dealing with patients suffering from mental illness will also be given.

The Aide's Role in Falls Prevention *Presented By: Jan Helsper, RN*

Falls and the problems resulting from falls are a serious health threat for older adults. About one third of people living at home, who are age 65 or older, fall each year. One half to two thirds of nursing home residents fall each year. Most falls are preventable. The in-home aide will be able to describe common causes of falls, safety measures that can help prevent falls, and other tips that can be used while providing care to the patient.
